Artistic Residencies open to young creatives in Sarrabus, Gerrei, Trexenta and Campidano of Cagliari

Context

LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT implements the Local Development Program approved on July 8th, 2010 by the Director of the Local Development Branch of the Agriculture and Agro-pastoral Reform Department – Autonomous Region of Sardinia – with resolution number 13617/553, which has been updated on July 31st, 2013 with resolutions number 13707/517 and 16796/1094.

The Director of the Local Development Branch has also approved on November 17th, 2014, with resolution number 24067/2048, the request for funding on “Azione di Sistema 2 – *Mobilizzazione degli Operatori e della Popolazione Locale Attraverso Eventi* – Fasi B e C” presented by LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT.

This call is part of the “Azione di Sistema 2 – *Mobilizzazione degli Operatori e della Popolazione Locale Attraverso Eventi*”. Azione di Sistema 2 aims at:

- the organization of promotional events as a way to enhance territorial animation
- the strengthening of territorial networks and the integration among local actors (tourism, production, itineraries, environment and culture)
- the organization of a happening (“Festa”) made of public performances and events within the framework of a shared Cultural Plan
- territorial promotion through the engagement and the empowerment of local stakeholders and external visitors

Azione di Sistema 2 – *Mobilizzazione degli Operatori e della Popolazione Locale Attraverso Eventi* is structured in **three phases**:

- A. “**Let’s find an idea for GAL SGT Festival together**” to define the guiding topic for all the events and the “Festa”. The guiding topic is *Geografie Sommerse. Viandanti nella bellezza dell’abitare il territorio del GAL SGT (Below the line geographies. Wayfarers in the beauty of living LAG Sole Grano Terra territory)*
- B. “**Let’s rediscover GAL SGT territory together**”, to stimulate a process of territorial mobility which is part of the “Festa”, to engage local population through workshops for children, young people, and local companies
- C. “**Let’s celebrate our territory together**”, with public events planned during summertime 2015, as described in the Cultural Plan

Artistic Residency

LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT gives home to creativity, offering a space to develop artistic and cultural project during an Artistic Residency. This call is open to young artists willing to explore multidisciplinary creative processes (dance, theatre, music, sing, visual arts, performances and installations).



The Artistic Residency is meant as a community and a place where young artists and local and international creatives can share a place, feelings and experience to challenge the common views on Art, merging it with everyday life through unconventional scenarios and new ideas for LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT district. The Artistic Residency also gives young people the opportunity to compare their creativity with colleagues from other countries and cultures, and to share the results of their projects.

The Residency is a regenerating cultural and meeting place open to local and international artists committed to work in the LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT district. We are looking for creatives willing to engage the local population through new forms of interaction between art, society and the territory. Key concepts for the Artistic Residency are landscape, game, travel, history, tradition-innovation, rituals, time (future, present, past), spaces (real and visionary), “below the line geographies”.

Each artist will be able to develop her/his work in a multidisciplinary contest, in a shared space with other professionals from different countries. Artists will give back their work to the district through performances and installations to be showed during the public events scheduled **from September 4th to September 6th, 2015** for ***Geografie Sommerse - Viandanti nella bellezza dell’abitare il territorio del GAL SGT***. The creative process will be guided by international artists with a wide experience selected by the Artistic Director.

Requested profile

The Artistic Residencies are open to 15 young artists and creatives from LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT district, over 18 years old, and up to 5 more young international and professional contemporary artists with a focus on *performance*/installations. International residencies are subject to approval by the Autonomous Region of Sarinina.

Length and time of the artistic residency

The Artistic Residencies will take place within one of the 19 municipalities of LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT **from August 23rd, 2015 to September 6th, 2015** for a total of **15 days**.

Participation

Candidates must fill and send the **Attachment 1** (“Allegato 1”) together with **CV** in European format, **cover letter** and copy of an **ID** to info@galsgt.it or info@pec.galsgt.it. Documents can also be sent as a printed letter via regular mail to:

Selection

Candidates will be selected by the Artistic Director on CV and cover letter.

Selection will give priority to young artists (between 18 to 40 years old) from LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT district with greater artistic experience. In case of a tie, younger candidates will be chosen. Selected participants will be contacted directly, while results will be published on LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT website www.gasgt.it

Services

LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT offers:

- travel costs related to flight/ferries up to € 300,00 (three hundreds euros) for artists not living in Sardinia, after approval from the Autonomous Region of Sardinia
- room and full board in one of the 19 municipalities of LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT (limited to the duration of the Artistic Residency)
- daily work in the assigned space (time and other aspects to be agreed)
- opportunities for artistic growth and to share knowledge with artistic direction, promoters and other artists
- scheduling of the performances in the public events planned for **Geografie Sommerse - Viandanti nella bellezza dell'abitare il territorio del GAL SGT**, on September 4th–6th, 2015
- promotion on LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT website and other networks
- technical support
- SIAE fee for copyrighted music to be used during performances within **Geografie Sommerse - Viandanti nella bellezza dell'abitare il territorio del GAL SGT**
- raw materials for performances (if sustainable with the budget allocated for this expense)
- insurance

There is no refund for anything not mentioned in this list.

Artists' duties

- take good care of the assigned spaces
- participate at the public performances **Geografie Sommerse - Viandanti nella bellezza dell'abitare il territorio del GAL SGT**
- guarantee the intellectual property of the proposals



- include the statement *“Performance/Installation made during the artistic residency promoted by LAG Sole Grano Terra SGT within Geografie Sommerse”* in any exhibition or distribution of the production created for Geografie Sommerse
